an international scientific conference

LANGUAGES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES IN CONTACT: REMEMBRANCE CULTURE

on the 4th of October 2025 at the Faculty of Philosophy in Novi Sad

Following the successful organization of the conference *Languages and Social Sciences in Contact: The Challenges of Interdisciplinarity* on 5 October 2024, we are pleased to announce our intention to hold another conference this year, this time focusing on the theme of the ***Culture of Remembrance***.

Memory culture, as a form of collective memory shared by a group of people within the same culture, is an inherently interdisciplinary field that primarily combines insights from *historiography* and *cultural studies*. However, it can also be approached from *psychological*, *pedagogical*, *sociological*, or *philosophical* perspectives. Moreover, it offers a valuable framework for research in the fields of *language* and *literature*, making it a potential meeting ground for researchers from various disciplines.

We hope you will respond to this invitation and kindly ask that you submit an abstract of your presentation, which may fall within (but is not limited to) the aforementioned areas.

Due to the country's current socio-political situation, we are not yet able to confirm whether the conference will be held in person or online. You will be informed of the format in time. The working languages of the conference are English and Serbian. Presentations may be given in any of the languages spoken in ex-Yugoslavia, but abstracts and papers must be submitted in either English or Serbian. Each presentation will last 20 minutes. The participation fee for the conference is 3000 RSD.

Instructions for writing an abstract

Abstracts should contain the following elements:

1. An author's (and a co-author's) name
2. An author's (and a co-author's) affiliation
3. An author's (and a co-author's) email
4. An abstract title – up to 15 words
5. A clear description of aims, methods and expected results of research - between 180 and 250 words
6. Key words - up to 10 words
7. .doc format, single line spacing, 11 Times New Roman font, justified.

Abstracts in English or Serbian should be submitted via email as a word attachment to the following address: interdisciplinarnost.konf@ff.uns.ac.rs by **June 15th**.

Students may submit abstracts (formatted according to the given guidelines) to be presented during the poster session.

Notification of acceptance will be sent by **June 30th**. The conference programme and the book of abstracts will be published by the end of September.

Conference proceedings will be published in an electronic collection of papers. Deadline for paper submission is **November 1st**, and the collection of papers will be tentatively published during 2026.
